## Introduction to Five-Year Actions Table and Reports

The Action Agencies are designing an information system and data base to help manage the large amount of information relevant to implementation of the Biological Opinions and to provide accurate and complete reporting of our plans and progress. When completed, the data base will include information about the specific projects that the Action Agencies plan to implement such as:

- implementation schedule,
- Action Agency lead,
- priority,
- link to the Biological Opinion,
- applicable Strategy,
- Province and subbasin,
- benefited ESU or species, and
- other relevant information.

Being in the developmental stage, the information in the data base has not yet been carefully reviewed, confirmed, or corrected. In order to give the reader an appreciation of the comprehensive scope of our planned actions, we are providing our Five-Year Actions Table to show the array of information that we plan to track and report. As you review the Five-Year Actions Table (available on the [www.salmonrecovery.gov](http://www.salmonrecovery.gov) website), you may notice areas where information is lacking (i.e. no priority identified, schedule not noted, etc.) or incorrect (i.e. Province or ESU/species, misidentified Biological Opinion link, etc.). The Five-Year Action Table reports the unvalidated data as it currently resides in the data base. The Action Agencies, with help and input from others, will continue to improve the information in the data base and the data base design.

In Appendix D we are also providing to you three reports. These reports are derived from the Five-Year Actions Table and represent different displays of the same information.
