Defendants and any allied parties will file their response(s) to all motions 28 days after the filing of such motions;

Plaintiffs and any other movant will file their reply 14 days after defendants' (and others) response(s).

The opening briefs in support of or in opposition to any motion shall be limited to 35 pages. The replies of movants shall be limited to 25 pages. Plaintiffs and Defendants ask the Court to set argument on the motions at a date convenient with the Court but no earlier than one week after the replies are filed.
